Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time (A) - 21st June, 2020

1st Reading: Jeremiah 20:10-13

Jeremiah said: "I hear the whisperings of many: 'Terror on every side! Denounce! let us denounce him!' All those who were my friends are on the watch for any misstep of mine. 'Perhaps he will be trapped; then we can prevail, and take our vengeance on him.'

But the LORD is with me, like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph. In their failure they will be put to utter shame, to lasting, unforgettable confusion.

O LORD of hosts, you who test the just, who probe mind and heart, let me witness the vengeance you take on them, for to you I have entrusted my cause. Sing to the LORD, praise the LORD, for he has rescued the life of the poor from the power of the wicked!"

Responsorial Psalm 69:8-10, 14, 17, 33-35

But death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who did not sin after the pattern of the trespass of Adam, who is the type of the one who was to come.

Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father."

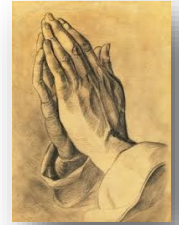

Covid 19 Social Restriction Guidelines for worship as at 22nd June 2020

If you would like to come to Mass on any day it is important that you reserve a place. You can do by calling the Presbytery the day before your attendance between 10.30 am and 1.30 pm. Please be aware that churches are limited to fifty people. However, the four square metre rule affects both our parish churches. So we are limited to thirty-four people in Our Lady of the Rosary, Kyneton and eighteen people in St Mary Magdalen's church in Trentham. This is not about distancing between people which is 1.5 metres but is about building capacity.

When you arrive at Church, you will be asked to sign a sheet giving just your first name and a contact phone number. These will be kept in the Presbytery for Twenty Eight days and then destroyed.

When you arrive at Church there will be hand sanitiser available and it would be appreciated by all in our communities for those attending Mass that you might use it. Please also be aware that all hard service are sanitised at the conclusion of Mass. Your co-operation in this process would be much appreciated by indicating that a pew has been sat on by leaving the kneeler in front of that pew down.

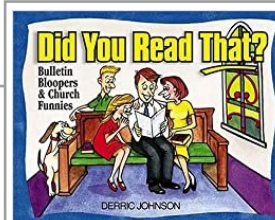
There are no changes to numbers for Weddings (20), Baptisms (20). Funerals for our parish churches remain affected by the four square metre rule.

I am aware how hard it for a lot of people who cannot attend Mass at the moment. So as we can celebrate Eucharist publicly on a limited basis, its so important that we comply with what is asked of us in these guidelines. A full copy of which is available in each of the sacristys of our combined parishes.
